REGION I POLOS	HOD must pick up Region I Polo's for their state between 2pm-4pm at the HQ hotel (Fredericksburg Hospitality House) on Thursday June 29. Region I Polo MUST be worn Thursday night (June 29 th) and Monday night (July 3 rd).

Wednesday, June 28th EARLY ARRIVAL	CHECK-IN for early arrival will be from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the front desk of the Eagle Landing Residence Hall, located next to a Giant food market, address: 1245 Jefferson Davis Highway, Fredericksburg, VA 22401. Each person will receive a key for their room. After 2:00 PM arrivals should check-in at Eagle Landing. The desk is staffed 24 hours a day.
