

## **Region I Policy and Procedure Regarding Players Selected to Regional Pools and Events**

- Players selected to the regional pools in July must tryout for their state Olympic Development Program the following year to be eligible to participate in any Regional, international or domestic event, both boys and girls.
- Each state will be sent a list via email after regional camp listing the players who have been selected to their age group pool.
- The state association will communicate to the Region 1 ODP Director that all players are registered with their state, attended tryouts, were selected and are participating.
- If the selected player tried out for the state ODP program, and did not make the team, he/she will still be a member of the Region Pool. If the player is selected, they must participate in the state program.
- The first regional events happen in November. Some states do not complete try outs by this time, so a player selected to the pool in July must be registered for the upcoming year to be allowed to participate in any Regional event in November.
- The only exception to this rule will be if a state association does not have an age group for the player the following year, (some states do not have a U17 program). The player will then be allowed to participate in Regional events for the upcoming year.
